Registered Nurse- 1 Permanent

Primary Function: To work collaboratively under the direction of the Health and Recreation Director, the Registered Nurse will provide nursing services and education to the community members of the Couchiching First Nation. The Registered Nurse will provide and maintain all aspects and beliefs of the traditional, western and Anishinabek culture.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Planning and delivery a Community Health Program, considering the physical, social, spiritual, mental, and environmental factors which influence everyone, family, and community.
- Work collaboratively with the RPN, CHR and PSW, to ensure immunization, chronic disease, maternal, diabetic, educational, medical interventions, and treatments are maintained.
 Deliver the community health programs -Preconception Health, Prenatal Health, Maternal, Newborn, Infant and Preschool Health and Community Health Services.

Qualifications:

- A four-year BScN degree is required: or minimum three-year nursing diploma is accepted.
- Be with good standing membership of the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Immunization Certificate- must be willing to obtain
- HCP-CPR and First Aid
