Summary: The Repatriation Worker will work under the direct supervision of the Obishikokaang Sagatay - Gamik Director. The Repatriation Worker will provide support and education to families the importance of proper Identification completion and guide them through the process in obtaining all identifications needed. The repatriation worker will also help families that are disconnected from the community find familial connections to the community.

Key Responsibilities are (but not limited to):

- Develop trusting professional relationships with families
- Ensure that all members of family have all necessary Identification that are serviced by Obishikokaang Sagatay Gamik
- Ensure that both parents are listed on identification documents
- Support families to make necessary changes on identification documents to reflect both parents
- Provide education to families on the importance of completing identification and impacts of not adding both parents
- Add information to client files
- Document and file all home visits and services provided

- 1–3 year work experience in child welfare is an asset
- Excellent interpersonal, written and oral communications skill
- Excellent time management skills
