Summary:

Lac Seul First Nation is seeking a skilled and motivated **Director of Housing O&M (Operations & Maintenance)** to provide strategic leadership and oversight for all housing operations and maintenance activities across the community. Under the direction of the Chief Administrative Officer, the Director will oversee both the Band Housing and Kenawind Housing portfolios, ensuring the effective planning, coordination, and delivery of housing programs that support safe, sustainable, and culturally appropriate homes for all community members.

The Director of Housing O&M plays a key role in strengthening housing systems, managing infrastructure projects, and ensuring alignment with the Nation's long-term development goals.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership and direction for all housing operations and maintenance functions across Band and Kenawind Housing portfolios.
- Develop and implement strategic plans, policies, and objectives for housing development and maintenance.
- Oversee all maintenance, repair, and construction projects, ensuring safety and quality standards are met.
- Conduct regular inspections of housing units and community infrastructure.
- Manage preventative maintenance programs and operational budgets.
- Supervise housing staff, contractors, and service providers to ensure efficient service delivery.
- Ensure compliance with housing, safety, and environmental regulations.
- Align Band and Kenawind housing policies for consistency and effectiveness.
- Identify and pursue funding opportunities through CMHC, ISC, and other agencies.
